Miners Jubilee Parade Entry Form

Date and Time: Saturday, July 18 Line up: 7:00 am Start time: 10:00 am

Parade staging area: Baker Middle School (on the corner of Fourth and Broadway)

Parade Rules

1. Entries may be historical, modern, or humorous, and uniquely decorated in design. Much of the audience is children. Sexually-oriented businesses will not be accepted.
2. All float lighting materials and decorations must be fire-retardant. Flammable materials will not be permitted (i.e. gasoline, kerosene, or open flame).
3. Candy and other material may be handed out to spectators along the parade route. Entrants may not squirt, shoot, or toss anything at the spectators. No air guns or weapons which act by force of gun powder or other explosive, or by jet propulsion, shall be fired or discharged within the city during the parade.
4. Horse entries will be allowed in the parade. Dog entries will be allowed but entrants must adhere to Baker City leash laws. Livestock, domestic animals, birds and reptiles are considered acceptable entries. Animal handlers are asked to provide "pollution patrol" crews to clean up after the animals.
5. Political parties or politicians may participate in the parade as long as there is no effort to sway public opinion or promote political agendas. The use of any political sign, political material or improper use of the American flag will not be tolerated.
6. Please follow the directions of parade officials. Keep pace with the parade line.
7. Baker County Chamber does not provide personal insurance for parade participants.
8. All participants may disband at any point beyond the intersection of First and Madison streets.

Note: All entries must observe applicable rules and regulations, or be barred from the parade. The Baker County Chamber and the Miners Jubilee Committee reserve the right to remove a parade entrant at any time during the parade that is not conforming to the rules and regulations, or is acting in an unsafe manner. All entries must be approved by the Miners Jubilee Committee at the time of application.

Float Requirements: Each float must be of sound construction. Driver must have full, clear vision while operating the float vehicle. The maximum dimensions are as follows; height 14', length 60', width 15'. The float may be self propelled or towed by a trailer or on a flat bed truck. Self propelled floats must have towing hitches in the front and rear (within easy access), and brakes must be in good working order. In

case of emergency, driver and participants must have a quick exit. Float operator must have a valid driver's license.
