

# Mason Dam Viewpoint Trail

## Wallowa-Whitman National Forest



*This short trail takes hikers down to a viewpoint above Mason Dam. From the viewpoint, visitors can enjoy a view the Phillips Lake, the Powder River below the dam and the Black Mountain area.*

**Total Miles:** 0.2 miles to the observation point above Mason Dam.

**Difficulty level:** Easy - More difficult

**Accessibility:** The trail is steep in some spots and not accessible for disabled users.

**Facilities and Attractions:** There are no facilities on this trail. However there are a few benches and some small signs identifying plants and a larger interpretive sign summarizing the construction of Mason Dam in 1968. A chain-link fence is constructed near the overlook but please use caution at the site with small children or pets. No parking fee is required.

**Directions:** From the Baker City Post Office, travel south on Highway 7 for *about* 16.3 miles to Forest Service 200 road which goes to the Mason Dam boat launch. Before you start to go down the hill, there is a turnout parking area alongside FS 200 road on the left. (You will need to go down and turn around at the boat launch, or make a safe u-turn on FS 200 road. The trail begins right at the turnout.
